Public Notice Mandatory Language for Monitoring and Reporting Violation Operational Evaluation Report

The MAXWELL WSC water system PWS ID TX0280003 has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section §290, Subchapter F. Public water systems in exceedance of an operational evaluation level are required to conduct an evaluation of their source water, treatment and distribution operations and submit a report of their findings to the TCEQ.

We failed to conduct an operational evaluation and/or submit a report to the TCEQ.

This/These violation(s) occurred in the monitoring period(s) quarter three 2021.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

We are currently still disinfecting with free chlorine. We are trying to manage water age and turnover tanks more often. We also will soon start blending our Edwards ground water with the CRWA surface water, to try and help bring down the TTHM concentration in the distribution system.
